- An advance directive is a way to tell your loved ones and doctors your wishes if something happens to you and you can't speak for yourself
- A directive can include the type and extent of your medical care. There are forms to help you write down your wishes.
- Learn the differences between guardianship, living wills, and durable powers of attorney.
