BUSINESS REPORTS:

March Expenditures: ATT, DMM for December/January/February, and \$13,121.78 in deposits.

COA now has 109 members; 30 have not renewed, and 3 organizations lack accurate contact information. Emails were sent to the 30 members who did not renew.

Senior Millage- We are in the 2nd quarter of FY 2025-2026. The 3rd 10-year renewal takes us to 2036. We are distributing over \$9 million in Genesee County through 39 contracts. A request for proposals will go out in March for auditing services for the senior centers, interpreter services, the senior medical transportation program, and programs for the visually and hearing-impaired.

Assisted a family with several choices for hospice agencies. Provided caregiver support groups for someone caring for a loved one with Alzheimer's disease. Assisted callers with utility assistance programs. Referred several callers to VAAA to determine eligibility for in-home help, as well as provided private duty agencies' phone numbers.
